

Chestatee Building

The Chestatee building acts as a hub for both student activities and services. On the first floor we have 3 main services. First is the academic advising office. Every student who comes to UNG will be issued an academic advisor. Their job is to make sure that you're taking the right classes, and that you're on track to graduate on time. After you reach 45 credit hours you will transition to a faculty advisor who will have a bit more practical knowledge in the field you are looking to go into, but in the beginning, you will receive your advising here.

Right next door is the Student Health services Office. This is a health clinic that is free for students to use. You can come here to get a vaccine, have a test done, or just because you don't feel to well. They can also prescribe medicine; however, you will have to get it filled at one of our many pharmacies in town. The staff here are all licensed registered nurses or nurse practitioners, not students practicing. And the last, and in my opinion the best part is that you can come into the self-care station and check out up to 3 free items per day. The items include chap stick, allergy medicine, bandaids, etc. every time I've had to come here, I have never had to wait more than 15 minutes to be seen. And last but not least we have our Military Clothing and Supply Store. This is where cadets can come to get all the things they need for their uniform.

On the second floor we have the UNG Bookstore. This is the best place to get all your UNG Merch. Hats, water bottles, sweatshirts, polos, t shirts, etc. it can all be found here. Also, as the name implies, you can get all the textbooks you need, and you can also get school supplies like pencils and scantrons. Right next to the bookstore we have our on campus Starbucks where you can get your daily coffee fix. Above the Starbucks on the 3rd floor we have an area for students to hangout, work, or meet with friends.

Also, on the 3rd floor we have the admissions office. They handle the admissions process up until you decide that this is where you want to go to school. Just across the lobby we have the cadet admissions office. The cadets have a separate admissions office that runs their process. And lastly, we have the registrar's office. They make sure students are getting credit for all the classes they're attending. They also handle the transfer of AP Credits from High School
