The library is one of my absolute favorite places on campus to be. It has a total of three floors, all of which contain many amenities for our students to utilize. Along with checking out normal library items like books and movies, students can also check out many different types of technology from the library, including iPads, cameras, and projectors. These items can be checked out for a period of 7 days, and you can only check out one piece of technology at a time. There are computers and printers available on every floor of the library, but the main computer lab is located on the first floor. Also on the first floor, there are scanners, wireless printing options, and color printing available. Another great feature of our library are the study rooms.
