The symposium review committee will select the most relevant and highest quality submissions for between nine and twelve scholars to present and discuss at the symposium. Undergraduate submissions will be considered for a poster session. Authors of selected abstracts will be invited to present as members of panels during the symposium.

Extended papers from the selected abstracts will be published by the University of North Georgia Press in a peer-reviewed and edited Symposium monograph.
