## **Panel Expert – Guidelines**

### BEE-2 Program Objectives

- Business environment immersion
- Critical thinking in ethical decision-making in business through scenarios
- Ethical defense through defending decisions to a live panel of business community leaders

Students will have gone through all seven ethical simulation scenarios and had 30 minutes to prepare to discuss these with the panel for each scenario.

The panel will then randomly select one of the seven scenarios to discuss with the group.

Reminder: There is NOT a rubric, as this is not a competition. We expect, as experienced business and community professionals within the North Georgia region, for you to provide only your advice to the students and to discuss the situation to provide value in critical thinking.

These are limited to 10 minute discussions, however, the panel will have 30 minutes with all the students together for discussion and advice in conclusion of the program.

- What was wrong or right?
- What would they do or what are the pros/cons if in the scenario it is the person conducting the unethical action?
- What are consequences to this type of action? Etc...
