## ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to participate in the CAMP program:

- A. The student must have participated, or be eligible to participate, in the Title I, Part C, Migrant Education Program (Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965) and produce a Certificate of Eligibility (COE).

**OR**

- B. The student **or** his/her immediate family member must have spent a minimum of 75 days during the past 24 months as a migrant/seasonal farm worker.
- i. “Seasonal farmworker” is defined as a person whose primary employment was in farm work on a temporary or seasonal basis (that is, not constant, year-round activity).
  - ii. “Migrant farmworker” is defined as a seasonal farmworker whose employment required travel that prevented him/her from returning to his/her home within the same day.

**OR**

- C. Student or his/her parent(s) or guardian must have participated or be eligible to participate in the Employment and Training Administration, National Farmworker Jobs Program (NFJP) or other services and activities established under Section 167 of the Workforce Investment Act (WIA).

**In addition**, the student must:

1. Be a US Citizen or Permanent Resident.
2. Be eligible to receive federal financial aid.
3. Be enrolled or be admitted for enrollment on a full-time basis (12 credit hrs) at the University of North Georgia – Gainesville campus as a first year student (under 30 credit hrs or less).
4. Be 16 years of age or older.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you for your interest in the University of North Georgia College Assistance Migrant Program (CAMP at UNG). All prospective students must be accepted to UNG Gainesville in order to be considered for CAMP. Students that have been accepted to UNG and have submitted all requested documentation for CAMP will have first priority. UNG CAMP serves 40 students; therefore, openings are limited. Please contact one of the recruiters at 678-717-3482 for assistance.

TIPS:

- Do not leave any blank spaces on the application. If it doesn't apply, write “N/A”
- Read, sign, and date where indicated.
- Include social security number, phone number(s) and an emergency contact number.
- If 17 years of age or under, have a parent or guardian sign where indicated.
- Keep a copy of all documents for recording purposes.
- Create a professional email (separate from an email you use for friends and family) for school and financial aid purposes.

- **CAMP Application** [begins on the next page] – Fill out all information and turn all documents in.
- **If currently or were part of the Migrant Education program (CEO) or any service under the Workforce Investment Act (NFJP), provide a CEO or an NFJP (if applicable)** – Request a copy from the appropriate office. The recruiter will provide assistance with this.
- **Employment Verification for Temporary/Seasonal Farm Work Sheet (if applicable)** - If a COE or an NFJP is not available, please ensure to complete the last section of the application.
- **FAFSA** – We will assist in the completion of the FAFSA; however, be sure to turn in a copy of the summary (**SAR**).
- **Parent AND student copies of Tax Return Transcript** (request a copy at [www.irs.gov](http://www.irs.gov)). If personal income (money you were paid) was earned, a copy of these documents MUST be provided.
- **Birth Certificate** – A copy must be submitted. In the case of permanent residency status, please submit a notarized and translated version of the birth certificate along with a copy of the original.
- **Social Security Card** – Submit a copy (front and back).
- **Driver's license/State ID** – Submit a copy (front and back).
- **Permanent Resident documentation (if applicable)** – Submit a copy (front and back).
- **Official High School or GED Transcript** – Request your high school counselor/guidance office to send the transcript to the CAMP office (mailing address is on the first page.) You can also provide a sealed envelope to us.
- **SAT or ACT Scores** – Submit a copy of your standardized test scores.
- **Cesar E. Chavez Reflection/Autobiography** – Submit ONE essay (up to three pages, double spaced) about Cesar Chavez and his work as an activist for farmworker's rights. We expect you to research The United Farm Workers Union, and, using this knowledge, write **not only** about Chavez, but about yourself and your family. Include family history, leadership experiences, and any information relevant to acceptance into CAMP. Discuss why you would like to be part of the College Assistance Migrant Program, and how Cesar Chavez's work has affected or inspired you. *A more detailed description of what should be included in the essay is on page 5.*
- **Photo** – Please submit a color or black and white photo. This photo will not be returned.
- **Housing/Childcare/Insurance Request Form** – If you want to request any of these services, you must request it when you apply for CAMP. Form will be given after the application has been started and there is a need.

**CAMP Eligibility**

To be eligible to participate in the CAMP program a person must be a **migrant or seasonal farm worker**, or a dependent of a **migrant or seasonal farm worker**. "Migrant farm worker" means a farm worker whose employment required travel that prevented the farm worker from returning to his or her home within the same day. "Seasonal farm worker" means a person who, within the past 24 months was employed for at least 75 days in farm work, and whose primary employment was in farm work on a temporary or seasonal basis (that is, not a constant year-round activity).

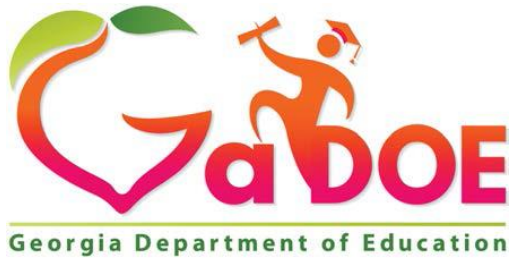
