- Submit your abstract in the Conference abstract submission system by November 18, 2025. https://ung.edu/college-of-arts-and-letters/conference-on-the-americas.php
- Completed papers are due by January 5, 2026 as an email attachment to lstrangesorial@gsu.edu
- Papers must be 3000-5000 words.
- Must include an abstract of no more than 300 words
- Topic must relate to Latin America, the Caribbean or Canada
- Must be in Word format.
- MLA, APA, or Chicago style (other styles must be approved by the Americas Council) Papers will be evaluated on their style, quality of research, and content. This conference is interdisciplinary; therefore, possible topics may include, but not limited to, the following: art, language, culture, travel, business, literature, and politics. Additionally, in order to be considered for an award, students must present their papers at the 29th Annual Conference on the Americas, to be held at the University of North Georgia on February 20 & 21, 2026. Students will be notified via e-mail by January 15, 2026 if their paper is accepted. There will be a prize awarded for the best undergraduate and the best graduate paper.
