

## **2023 Curriculum and Instruction Employer Survey**

### **About**

The Curriculum and Instruction (C & I) Employer Survey assesses the program's impact on candidates' skills and professional knowledge from the perspective of those who supervise the completers. The survey was developed collaboratively by the program faculty and the associate dean in 2018-2019 and was revised during the 2022-2023 academic year ahead of the spring 2023 implementation. The survey was revised to ensure that it will meet CAEP Sufficiency Criteria and provide actionable data in alignment with the program standards. The revised survey was piloted with a panel of external stakeholders who reviewed the employer survey, shared their interpretations of the questions, and provided feedback on questions. Their feedback was vital to this process, as panelists were school-based leaders and had a strong understanding of curriculum and instruction goals and needs. The survey questions were revised based on their feedback prior to the spring 2023 implementation. The Educator Preparation Provider (EPP) developed its surveys for completers and their employers, as the Georgia Professional Standards Commission (GaPSC) does not cover these completers in the surveys currently utilized by the state. The EPP administers the Curriculum and Instruction Employer Survey to employers by email one year after a student completes the program.

### **Discussion of Results**

The survey results below in Table 1, pages two to six, include our most recent data from the 2023 administration. The response rate was acceptable at 31.8%. The results indicated that employers are pleased with the skills and professional behaviors that completers demonstrate in the areas of curriculum, instruction, content, knowledge of students, research, assessment, and professional practices after completing the program. Of the seven employers responding, 100% indicated they were either satisfied or extremely satisfied with how the program impacted the educators. There were no recommendations or suggestions for improvements. Overall, the employer survey indicates that the program positively impacts candidates.

As the survey is administered annually, the EPP will aggregate results and analyze trends longitudinally. The EPP notes limitations to administering a survey to employers a year after program completion. One limitation of the survey administration can be employer turnover and shifts of principals within school districts. At times, respondents may be new to their position or school and need to familiarize themselves with the educator they are evaluating. It is also possible for the employer to have not worked with the educator before their enrollment in the program and subsequent completion. This can limit their comparison of the educator's performance and the amount of information they can contribute in their responses.
