## **Steps to Apply for University Admissions**

- Apply for admission to the University of North Georgia using <u>GA Futures</u>. Both Georgia and outof-state residents create an account with GA Futures to apply. If you cannot apply online, download a paper application and submit it to the <u>Office of Undergraduate Admissions</u>. All applicants, online and paper, will pay a non-refundable application fee.
- On the admission application, you will need to select **General Studies BSN** for your intended major.
- Submit your official transcripts. You will need to submit an official transcript from each institution you have attended. We must receive the transcripts through e-script, Parchment, National Student Clearinghouse, or another secure transcript delivery service directly from the institutions: choose Admissions Imaging Center or use <u>admissions-gvl@ung.edu</u> as the intended recipient.
  Note: Transcripts sent by the student or parent are not considered official

<u>Check your admission status</u> often to make sure we have received all your required documents.

## **Steps to Apply to the Department of Nursing**

- Once fully accepted to the University, you must apply for admission to the nursing program. You will find the BSN application in your Banner Web account.
- Register for the HESI A2 exam at one of the <u>UNG Testing Centers</u> or at a Prometric Testing Center using **201234** as UNG's ID number. The exam must be taken within twelve months prior to the application deadline and may only be taken twice per calendar year. There must be six or more weeks between exam dates.
- UNG Nursing department requires students to be tested on the following sections of HESI and must have a **minimum score of 66% or higher in each of the sections**:
  - Anatomy & Physiology
  - Math Built-in calculators will be permitted; however, personal calculators are not permitted.
  - Reading Comprehension
  - Vocabulary
