### Registration:

Complete the [eCore Introduction Quiz](#) to obtain the required eCore pre-requisite. Wait 15 minutes for Banner to process your completion. Register for eCore courses in **Banner**. eCore courses are noted with a G next to the section (ex. ENGL 1101 01G).

- Short Session I section number = 5XG (MATH 1111 50G)
- Short Session II section numbers = 8XG (MATH 1111 82G)
