CORE CURRICULUM REQUIREMENTS

- (§) UNG students are required to complete 60 credits of general education requirements (Core Curriculum). The Core Curriculum allows students to select courses from seven areas: Institutional Priority; Mathematics & Quantitative Skills; Political Science & U.S. History; Arts, Humanities & Ethics; Communicating in Writing; Technology, Mathematics, & Sciences; Social Sciences.

Cost of a summer at UNG: \$6,000-10,000 vs Cost of a summer abroad: \$6,000-\$12,000

Cost of a semester at UNG: \$14,000-20,000 vs Cost of a semester abroad: \$11,000-\$30,000
