### A GUIDE TO STUDY ABROAD

### **CORE CURRICULUM REQUIREMENTS**

- (§) UNG students are required to complete 60 credits of general education requirements (Core Curriculum). The Core Curriculum allows students to select courses from six areas: Communication and Quantitative Skills; Institutional Options; Humanities, Fine Arts, and Ethics; Natural Sciences, Mathematics, and Technology; Social Science; and Area of Concentration.

### **COST COMPARISON\***

Cost of a summer at UNG: \$11,000-12,000 vs Cost of a summer abroad: \$5,000-\$11,000

Cost of a semester at UNG: \$24,000-25,000 vs Cost of a semester abroad: \$10,000-\$22,000
