### A GUIDE TO STUDY ABROAD

East Asian Studies majors are required to complete a study abroad experience as part of their degree program. This guide is designed to introduce you to the opportunities that studying abroad brings to your major. #### **MAJOR SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS**

- Study abroad in the country of your concentration: Taiwan (for China concentration), Japan, or South Korea
- S Earn between 9-15 credits

#### **COST COMPARISON\***

Cost of a summer at UNG: \$6,000-10,000 vs Cost of a summer abroad: \$6,000-\$12,000

Cost of a semester at UNG: \$14,000-20,000 vs Cost of a semester abroad: \$11,000-\$30,000

\*Cost estimates include: tuition, fees, housing, meals, travel, and insurance. Costs are subject to change.
