COST COMPARISON*

Cost of a summer at UNG: \$11,000-12,000 vs Cost of a summer abroad: \$5,000-\$11,000

Cost of a semester at UNG: \$24,000-25,000 vs Cost of a semester abroad: \$10,000-\$25,000
