International Affairs majors are required to complete a study abroad experience as part of their degree program. This guide is designed to introduce you to the opportunities that studying abroad brings to your major. MAJOR SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

- Must be in region of concentration
- Minimum length of 4 weeks
- Earn at least 3 credits

STUDY ABROAD CAN HELP YOU

- Increase your understanding of yourself and challenge your perceptions of the world
- Enhance employment opportunities by providing real-life experience and adaptability

FINANCIAL SUPPORT

- Use federal, state and other financial aid. i.e. Pell, Hope/Zell
- Institutional and national study abroad scholarships available
- CGE/NCS provide assistance in researching and applying for funding sources

COST COMPARISON*

Cost of a summer at UNG: \$11,000-12,000 vs Cost of a summer abroad: \$5,000-11,000

Cost of a semester at UNG: \$24,000-25,000 vs Cost of a semester abroad: \$10,000-25,000

*Costs estimates include: tuition, fees, housing, meals, travel, and insurance. Costs are subject to change.

Discuss how the program fits into your academic plan. You can find your academic advisor on the [Tranguid in Banner](#).

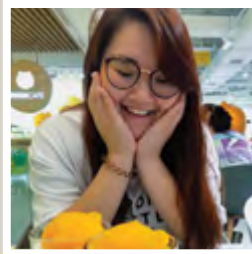
