COST COMPARISON*

Cost of a summer at UNG: \$6,000-7,000 vs Cost of a summer abroad: \$6,000-14,000

Cost of a semester at UNG: \$14,000-15,000 vs Cost of a semester abroad: \$10,000-25,000
