#### MAJOR SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

- All CRJU courses require a prerequisite of CRJU1100- Introduction to Criminal Justice
- Must have a grade of C or higher in all courses with CRJU prefix

- 💲 Explain the unique Constitutional distinctions between the systems.
- (\$\footnote{\text{The Interval of Procedural Mechanisms in the foreign system that relate to specifically to emergency response, evidence collections, international terrorism, political involvement, and preventative strategies.
- Assess threats to vulnerable populations and locations inherent to a free society.
- Describe the responsibilities of actors within the particular foreign criminal justice system and their ability to work inclusively with diverse populations both victims and suspects alike.
- Discuss the risks, challenges, and innovations to nationalized police efforts that vary from American justice systems in force applied and alternative adjudications.
