MAJOR SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

- While History majors are not required to study abroad, it is highly encouraged.
- The degree program is flexible and allows students to take upper division courses focused in different regions:
 Asia, Africa, Latin America, Middle East, or World history.

COST COMPARISON*

Cost of a summer at UNG: \$6,000-10,000 vs Cost of a summer abroad: \$6,000-\$12,000

Cost of a semester at UNG: \$14,000-20,000 vs Cost of a semester abroad: \$11,000-\$30,000
