## A GUIDE TO STUDY ABROAD

# INTERNSHIP AND SERVICE LEARNING REQUIREMENTS

- Students must have earned at least 48 credits at UNG by the start of the experience.
- Placement process will begin after student's acceptance into the program.
- Placement and start dates will vary based on whether it is a team or individual internship.

# VIRTUAL INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITIES CAN HELP YOU

- Make real connections with people in other countries through hands-on projects and interactive experiences.
- Gain skills that are important for career-readiness while still being cost-effective and earning academic credit.
- Strengthen your understanding of yourself and challenge your perceptions of the world.

#### COST COMPARISON\*

Cost of a summer at UNG: \$6,000-10,000 vs Cost of a summer abroad: \$6,000-\$12,000

Cost of a semester at UNG: \$14,000-20,000 vs Cost of a semester abroad: \$11,000-\$30,000

\*Cost estimates include: tuition, fees, housing, meals, travel, and insurance. Costs are subject to change.

## **Internships & Service Learning for All Students:**

#### **WORLDSTRIDES: INTERNSHIPS ABROAD**

- Locations: Australia, New Zealand, England, Ireland, Spain, Japan, South Korea, Vietnam, Singapore
- **Program Length:** 8 or 12 weeks (Summer or Semester)
- \*Credits: 3-6 credit hours
- (§) Fields: Agriculture & Veterinary Sciences; Architecture & Urban Planning; Arts & Humanities; Business & Marketing; Communication, Media, & PR; Education; Engineering; Environmental & Sustainability Studies; Fashion; Film & TV; Health; Hospitality, Events, & Tourism; Information Technology & Computer Science; Legal Studies & Advocacy; Performing & Visual Arts; Political Science; Psychology & Social Work; Research; Science & Math; Sports & Exercise Science
- **Price Range:** \$10,000-12,000 (8 weeks) or \$13,000-17,000 (12 weeks)
  - \*varies by program length, hours worked, and placement; credit hours determined by UNG academic department supervising internship

#### **WORLDSTRIDES: COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT**

- (S) Location: Morocco, South Africa, Ireland, Spain, Chile, Costa Rica, Peru
- **Program Length:** 4-8 weeks (Summer)
- (§) **Description:** Community Development, Education, Environment, Family & Youth Development, Health, Human Rights
- Price Range: \$5,000-10,000
   \*Some programs may require certain language level proficiency to participate

#### **CIEE: INTERNSHIPS ABROAD**

- ♠ Locations: England, Ireland, Scotland, Australia, New Zealand, Spain, Italy, France, Germany, Denmark, Estonia, Czech Republic, Portugal, Jordan, Morocco, South Africa, Ghana, Singapore, Japan, South Korea, Taiwan, Chile, Costa Rica
- Program Length: 8 weeks (Summer) or 12 weeks (Semester)
- **Credits:** 6-13 credit hours
- (§) Fields: Agriculture; Archaeology; Architecture; Arts; Business; Chemistry; Communication, Media, & PR; Education; Electronics; Energy; Engineering; Entertainment; Environment & Sustainability; Fashion; Film; Government; Healthcare & Public Health; Hospitality; Human Resources; Human Rights; IT & Computer Sciences; Journalism; Law; Politics; Psychology; Sciences; Social Development; Sports; Technology
- **Price Range:** \$10,000-14,000 (summer) or \$13,000-17,000 (semester)
  - \*varies by program length, hours worked, and placement; credit hours determined by UNG academic department supervising internship

## ISEP: INTERN ABROAD WITH THE INTERN GROUP (TIG)

- (§) Locations: Thailand, Ireland, England, Spain, Australia, Japan, or Virtual
- **Program Length:** 4-24 weeks (Summer or Semester)
- \*Credits: 6-12 credit hours
- Fields: Placement depends on chosen field of student
- Price Range: \$7,000-9,000 (4 weeks) or \$20,000-\$22,000 (24 weeks); \$2,000-\$4,000 (virtual)
  \*varies by program length, hours worked, and placement; credit hours determined by UNG academic department supervising internship

#### **SIT: INTERNSHIPS**

- Nocations: Approximately 40 locations across Africa, Asia, Australia, Europe, Latin America, and the Middle East
- Program Length: 6 weeks (Summer) or included as part of a Semester study abroad program
- \*Credits: 6-7 credit hours
- Fields: Placements located primarily at local community organizations, health institutions, research centers, government agencies, or international Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs)
- Price Range: \$11,000-14,000 (summer internship only) or \$25,000-\$30,000 (if part of semester study abroad program) \*varies by program length, hours worked, and placement; credit hours determined by UNG academic department supervising internship

- (S) Locations: Athens, Greece
- **Program Length:** 4 weeks (Summer)
- **Credits:** 3-9 credit hours
- Fields: Illegal Immigration, Human Trafficking, Maritime Security, NATO Operations, Security Challenges, International Relations
- Sample Courses: POLS or INTL Internship Credit
- **Price Range:** \$7,000-\$9,000

- **Locations:** Virtual (Online)
- Program Length: Semester or Summer
- Credits: 3 credit hours
- Sample Courses: BUSA 2999 Special Topics in Business, BUSA 4903 - Internship in Business Administration or MKTG 4903 - Marketing Internship
- Price Range: \$1,700-\$2,000
