A GUIDE TO EDUCATION ABROAD

Spanish majors are encouraged to complete an education abroad experience as part of their degree program. This guide is designed to introduce you to the opportunities that education abroad brings to your major. MAJOR/MINOR SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

- Students who study abroad can satisfy many of the classes required in the Department of Spanish and Portuguese plan of study.
- (*) Obtaining a minor in Spanish requires students to complete, or receive credit in, the elementary and intermediate language sequences (SPAN 1001 through SPAN 2002) plus 4 upper-division classes of the student's choosing.
- To obtain a Spanish major, students must complete, or receive credit in, the lower and intermediate language sequences, as well as
 - Intro to Literature (SPAN 3110)
 - Intro to Spanish Linguistics (SPAN 3400)
 - Grammar and Composition (SPAN 3510)
 - An internship course (SPAN 4995)
 - Plus 7 additional 3000/4000 level SPAN courses.

- Develop greater linguistic proficiency in Spanish.
- Broaden your cultural competencies of the Spanish speaking worlds.
- Maximize critical thinking skills alongside native speakers.
- Apply concepts learned in class by making connections to Spanish-speaking cultures.

Cost of a summer at UNG: \$6,000-10,000 vs Cost of a summer abroad: \$6,000-\$12,000

Cost of a semester at UNG: \$14,000-20,000 vs Cost of a semester abroad: \$11,000-\$30,000
