During the summer academy, you will visit many attractions in Atlanta and North Georgia to learn about American history, culture *and have fun!*



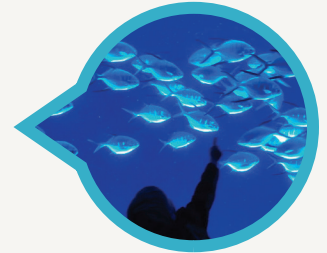
ATLANTA ATTRACTIONS:

LOCAL ATTRACTIONS:

HISTORIC SITES:

Visit the Jimmy Carter Presidential Library and Museum to learn about President Jimmy Carter's life and work from his childhood in Plains, Georgia to the work he and Mrs. Carter do around the world.

Visit the Martin Luther King, Jr. National Historic Site to see the Civil Right leader's birthplace, the church where he preached, and the memorial site where he and his wife were buried.
