In the spring of 2020, one writer of an exemplary English 1101 and one writer of an exemplary English 1102 papers will be awarded the English 1101 and English 1102 Inman Quill Award. In addition to the distinction of having won the award, each winner will receive a certificate at the Honors Assembly and a check for \$100.

Also, each winner's essay will be published in the *Chestatee Review*.

Judging Criteria:

A faculty committee will judge the papers, considering the following:

- Sophistication of Critical Thinking Skills
- Originality of Thought/Creativity
- Effectiveness of Expression
- Persuasiveness
- Polished Writing Style

To Submit:

1. Each student may enter either or both awards, but may submit only one paper per award. The paper must have been submitted for a grade in the class at UNG during Spring, Summer, or Fall semesters 2019.
2. The paper must be revised so that:
 - it is free of instructor's comments and grade.
 - it is error-free and uses MLA format.
 - it does not include the student's or the instructor's name.
 - its context and purpose is apparent within the work itself.
3. A single coversheet **MUST** be submitted with the essay. Fill in the attached sheet.
4. Submit entry, as a single Word document attachment, by email to Dr. Courtney Ferriter Courtney.Ferriter@ung.edu by 11:59 pm Sunday, February 16th, 2020. "Inman Quill Essay" should appear in the subject line.
5. Submitters will be notified of results by email by March 6th, 2020.
