Written in 2024

In the spring of 2025, one writer of an exemplary English 1101 paper and one writer of an exemplary English 1102 paper will be awarded the English 1101 and English 1102 Inman Quill Award for the previous calendar year of 2024.

In addition to the distinction of having won the award, each winner will receive a certificate at the Honors Assembly and a check for \$100.

Also, each winner's essay will be published in the *Chestatee Review*.

Judging Criteria:

A faculty committee will judge the papers, considering the following:

- Sophistication of Critical Thinking Skills
- Originality of Thought/Creativity
- Effectiveness of Expression
- Persuasiveness
- Writing Style

To Submit:

1. Each student may enter either or both awards, but may submit only one paper per award. The paper must have been submitted for a grade in a class at UNG during Spring, Summer, or Fall semesters 2024.
2. The paper must be revised so that:
 - it is free of instructor's comments and grade.
 - it is error-free and uses MLA format.
 - it does not include the student's or the instructor's name.
 - its context and purpose are apparent within the work itself.
3. A single coversheet MUST be submitted with the essay. Fill in the attached sheet.
4. Submit entry, as a single Word document attachment, by email to Kendra Sanderson at Kendra.sanderson@ung.edu by 11:59 pm January 22, 2025. "Inman Quill Essay" should appear in the subject line.
