## Connecting to UNG-Guest Wi-Fi

UNG-Guest Wi-Fi is available to guests of the University that do not have UNG Credentials.

Note – **UNG-Guest Wi-Fi** should only be used by users that <u>do not have UNG credentials</u>. If you have UNG credentials, please use the **UNG**, or **RESNet/RESNet-Media Wi-Fi** if in the dorms.

- 1. Search for Wi-Fi from your device (Windows 10/11, MacOS, iOS, AndroidOS, ChromeOS).
- 2. Select **UNG-Guest**.
- 3. The Captive Portal window may automatically open -or- navigate to your preferred browser (Chrome, Edge, FireFox, Safari).
- 4. Your web browser should load a Captive Wi-Fi page that looks like the image below:



5. Read and click on the box next to **I accept the Terms of Service** (the box will have a checkmark when you click on it).



- 6. Next select a method to sign into the Wi-Fi by clicking on one of the options. There will be two options:
  - A. Sign in with email
  - B. Sign in with text message




## Option A - Sign in with email

- o Provide your name and a valid email address.
- You can also click the box next to Use alternate email address if you want to provide an additional email.
- Click on Send Access Code
- The Captive Portal will now update and ask for you to enter an access code.



- An email will be sent to the provided email address with the access code for sign-in.
- Navigate to your email and look for an email from noreply@mist.com (check your junk/spam folder if you do not see it after a couple minutes). This email will provide you with the access code.
- Type the access code into the Captive Portal page, and select Sign In.



 The Captive Portal will close, and you should now be connected and have internet connectivity.

## Option B - Sign in with Text Message

o Provide your name and a valid email address.




 Using the drop-down menu under Mobile Carrier, Select your mobile phone service provider.




o Next provide your mobile phone number (numbers only).

- Type the access code into the Captive Portal page, and select Sign In.
