Note: The purpose of this table is to demonstrate adequate fulltime faculty in each of the disciplines. The list of "departments" was created to provide consistency across the two institutions; however, disaggregation of school areas occasionally resulted in "departments" at the Gainesville and Oconee campuses where no disciplinary degree program existed (e.g. Religion). Traditionally, GSC has not added fulltime faculty to a department until it offers at least a major. The disaggregation also necessitated a duplicated faculty count as many faculty at GSC taught across "departments." Both GSC and NGCSU had faculty that taught at multiple campuses.
