




Dahlonega


Global Learning Community

BIOLOGY (B.S.)

- Small Class Sizes with dedicated faculty and advising.

Cybersecurity

- UNG is designated as a National Center for Academic Excellence in Cyber Defense by the Department of Homeland Security and the National Security
- As a state military institution, UNG's Cyber Institute has recruited most faculty from US government NSA. Many domestic students go on to intern or start careers with FBI/CIA. International students are placed in corporate internships in the Atlanta area. A lot of Fortune 500 companies recruit our students.

Concentration in Information Assurance and Security (IAS) option.

Psychology (B.S.)

- Small classes, individual attention.
- Research driven program and is required to graduate, even as an undergraduate degree. Students are paired with a professor doing research and assist.
- A minor is required for psychology majors. Popular minors include biology, sociology, and human services and administration.
- Typically, students graduate having published in a psychology journal.
- Eligible for STEM OPT 2-year Extension after graduation


- Graduates from Digital Arts concentration have started careers in film special effects for companies like Disney & Marvel
