Professional Licensure and Certification Information for Counseling Degree Programs

The University of North Georgia offers degree programs that fulfill the educational requirements for students to apply for professional licensure or certification in Georgia. However, these programs may not meet the educational requirements in other states.

Educational requirements vary by state or certification board, and there may be additional requirements that must be met. Students are encouraged to reach out to the program coordinator and the relevant licensing entity for further information and guidance.

Master of Science in Counseling

The Master of Science in Counseling degree at UNG was developed to meet the state and national regulatory criteria to be eligible to apply for licensure and certification as a Licensed Professional Counselor.
