## Master of Science with a Major in Athletic Training (MSAT)

Upon completion of the program, University of the North Georgia graduate will have **satisfied all educational requirements** and be eligible to sit for the Board of Certification (**BOC**) for the **Athletic Trainer Exam**.

The graduate must successfully pass the BOC and be in good standing to apply for an athletic trainer license.
