

Nursing Family Nurse Practitioner

The University of North Georgia offers degree programs that meet the educational requirements students need to apply for professional licensure and certifications in Georgia. The programs may not meet education requirements for licensure or certification in other states.

Students who plan to pursue professional licensure or certification in a state other than Georgia should contact the program coordinator and the appropriate licensing entity for additional information and guidance.

Master of Science in Nursing with a concentration in Family Nurse Practitioner (FNP)

Professional Licensure or Certification Disclosure

Upon completion of the program, University of North Georgia (UNG) graduates will have **satisfied all educational** requirements, and will be eligible to sit for the **Family Nurse Practitioner Certification** required for practice as an FNP in **all 50 states and the District of Columbia**.

Family Nurse Practitioner Certification

The [American Nurses Credentials Center](#) (ANCC) and [American Academy of Nurse Practitioners](#) (AANP) provide nurse practitioner board certification examinations. Upon successful national certification, the student (who already holds a registered nurse license in their state or a compact license) can apply for state licensure as a nurse practitioner.
