

WHY IS THIS IMPORTANT?

- All official UNG communication will go here, so you don't want to miss something important like your student invoice, housing contract, class information etc.



HOW CAN YOU ACCESS IT?

1. Visit my.ung.edu
2. Select "UNG E-mail"
 - a. This takes you directly to outlook

OR

- Download the Microsoft Outlook email app on your computer or smartphone.

#2 Navigating Banner

WHAT ALL WILL YOU FIND ON BANNER?

1. **Your UNG Tranguid:** This is your unofficial transcript.
2. **The Registration System:** Nighthawk Course Scheduler is what you will use to register for classes each semester.
3. **Financial Aid:** You can view and accept/deny your financial aid award each semester!
4. **Student Invoice:** Access your student invoice to view and pay.
5. **Class Book List:** Find out what materials you will need for the upcoming semester.
6. **Registration Agreement:** Each semester you will need to review and accept the registration agreement before being able to register for class!
7. **Personal Information:** If you need to update your personal information, you can do so here!

YOUR UNG TRANGUID

How to get there:

- 1. Log in to Banner**
- 2. Select Student**
- 3. Click the four white squares in the left upper corner**
- 4. Select Banner**
- 5. Select Student Records**
- 6. Click Student Tranguid (unofficial Transcript)**

#3 Online Course Systems

D2L

- This is the online course management system we use at UNG. Think of this kind of like google classroom or blackboard, which you may have used in high school or at a previous institution.
- All of your courses, both in person and online, will have a "shell" in D2L, but how your professor uses D2L can vary! They may use discussion threads, quizzes, tests, assignments, post content, etc.
- UNG D2L is only for UNG Students, Faculty and Staff, and UNG Courses. Your tranguid will say Online-D2L in the session column if you are scheduled for an online UNG class.

GoView

- This is the online course management system for any eCore classes.
- For eCore classes, all of your materials, test, quizzes, etc. will be done on here.
- GoView is used by any university student, faculty and staff in the University System of Georgia! You will only find eCore classes here.
- Your tranguid will say Online-GoView in the session column if you are scheduled for an eCore class! You will receive an email 1-2 weeks before classes begin with login information!


*These systems will look very similar because they are housed on the same platform, but have different logins and URLs. Also, be sure you are logging on at least one a day to make sure you keep up with any announcements and course work!

This is what your home page will look like once you are added to your courses. You will have access to this the Friday before classes begin!




First Day Inclusive Access

What if your professor has chosen to have their course materials available digitally in D2L on the first day of classes?

What this means for you:

- Discounted charges for these materials will be added to your student account invoice approximately 1 month before classes start.
- Your course materials will be available on D2L on the first day of class!
- You will have the option to opt out in D2L starting the first day of class, but keep in mind these are required materials for class and available to you at a discounted rate. It is best not to opt out, but if go to class and speak to you professor first if you plan to do so.

This is what you should see if you are logging into GoView. Once logged in, your home page should look similar to your D2L homepage. You should see your eCore classes under "My Courses".
